AFTER SCHOOL

DCC hosts TWO after school programs every school day. K-3 After School takes place at the elementary school from 2:50-5:30. Grades 4-8 After School Drop In takes place at DCC from 3:00-5:30. Middle School students are allowed to volunteer with our K-3 program. High School students may choose to volunteer at either program.

SUMMER CAMP/EXTENDED SUMMER SCHOOL
